

English

This term, the children will be reading the story of 'The Dark'. The children will immerse themselves in the text, innovate it and finally create their own exciting suspense stories. We will practise handwriting daily and encourage the children to write neatly on the line using a cursive script, paying attention to the relative size of their letters and using ascenders (tall letters) and descenders (letters that go below the line).

Science

Our topic this term is- 'Uses of Everyday Materials'. We will be investigating and testing the properties of materials. We will be working scientifically to ask questions and perform simple tests to answer these questions. The children will also learn about some current and historical material scientists.

Computing

In Computing, we will be learning about the use of Information Technology in our environment. We will also be learning about how to keep ourselves safe when working and playing online.

Theme
