Theme

Art: This term, the children will be learning about collage. We will look at artists that use collage.

<u>Science</u>

This term, we will be undertaking investigations that include finding out where we can find mini beasts in our school environment, adaption and thinking about the big questions of nature. We will learn about Charles Darwin and his importance in the science world.

We are also being courageous advocates and thinking about how we can look after our school environment.
