

English

In English, we will continue to develop our Talk for Writing skills and focus on accurate punctuation and spelling. We will begin the term by writing a set of instructions before moving onto our action story. We will be using the text, "The vial of tears" as a stimulus for our writing.

Science

In Science, we will be deepening our knowledge and understanding of plants and what they need to thrive and grow. We will do a fair test and record the results and analyse the data.



Computing

In Term 5, Year 3 pupils will continue developing their understanding of spreadsheets using Purple Mash. They will learn how to input and organise data more independently, using rows and columns effectively.

The children will be introduced to simple formulas to perform calculations, such as totals, and begin to explore how changing data can automatically update results. They will also learn how to create graphs and charts to present their findings clearly.

Art.

In Art, we will develop our skills in painting and focus on Marianne North a botanical artist.
