

English

In English, our 'Talk for Writing' focus is 'suspense'. We start with an extract from 'Sandy Cove adventure'. We will be identifying the tools used to make a good suspense story to create their own based on a Roman or Celtic point of view. Then we will look at our 'non-fiction' which is 'explosion in Pompeii'. The task will be writing newspaper reports.

In Destination Reader, we are carrying on with the Roman theme; using various Roman stories as well as non-fiction books, the children will be using key reading strategies.

Science

In Science, the children will be learning about states of matters. We will be exploring solids, liquids and gases along with their properties. How will each of the states react under different circumstances?

We will also be looking at Daniel Fahrenheit and Anders Celsius (two renowned scientists).

Computing

In Computing this term, we will be looking at creating podcasts. We will learn about recording, editing and producing podcasts linked to our Roman topic.

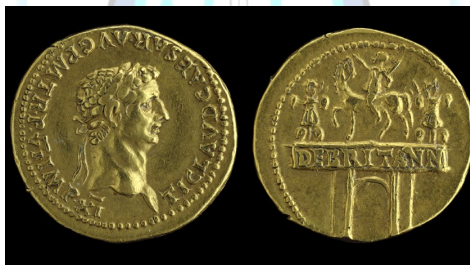
In online safety our focus will be on online relationships and how to stay safe.
