English

This term, we will be reading **We're going to find the Monster** and looking at instruction writing.

We will be building up to construct simple
sentences and punctuating them correctly.

The children will learn the role and function of
lists, labels and captions and will also begin to use
adjectives to make their writing more interesting.

Phonics - We will continue to follow 'Sounds Write', please keep an eye out on Classdojo for videos of new sounds.

Science

We will begin this term by learning about the human body. This will include naming the parts of the body and talking about what they do, understanding which body part is used for each sense and learning how to keep our bodies healthy. We will then start our learning around seasonal changes in 'Autumn'. This will involve looking at evergreen and deciduous trees, studying nocturnal animals, and investigating the best material to wear during the Autumnal weather.

This term, children will be introduced to 'Purple Mash'. They will be developing mouse skills and ICT skills using the creative 2DIY in Purple Mash.
