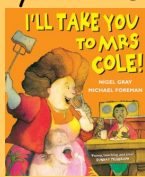


English

R.E.—In R.E. we will be looking at God and the creation story .

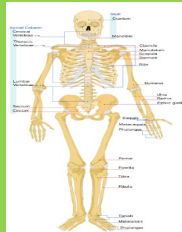
PE- We will be focusing on badminton skills & Outside Adventure Activities
