English

In our narrative work, we will explore 'Little Red' and learn how to create suspense in our writing. We will then move on to writing a persuasive letter. We will continue to practise our pre-cursive handwriting, as well as trying to remember to use capital letters, finger spaces and full stops.

Science

Pupils will continue to learn about the seasonal changes experienced in autumn. They will learn about nocturnal animals and how animals prepare for winter through an exciting Outreach session provided by the Education team at Mallydams Wood. Children will study Everyday Materials and learn about the historical Scientist, Charles Mackintosh.

Computing

Pupils will continue to develop their understanding of how to use 'Purple Mash'. This unit, 'Data Explorers', introduces children to using software tools to group and sort recognisable objects. By the end of the unit, children have the opportunity to collect simple data and present it in a pictogram.
