

English

This term, the children will be learning the story of 'The Storm Whale'. The children will immerse themselves in the text, innovate it and finally create their own exciting stories.

We will practice handwriting daily and encourage the children to write neatly on the line using a cursive script, paying attention to the relative size of their letters and using ascenders (tall letters) and descenders (letters that go below the line).

Science

Our topic this term is- 'Animals including Humans'. We will be thinking about the life cycles of humans and animals and how all animals produce young that grow into adults. We will carry out an investigation to demonstrate how important helmets are when cycling and we will discuss how to keep ourselves safe around medicines in the home.

Computing

This term in Computing, we will be learning how to create pictures. The unit is from the Purple Mash scheme and it teaches the children how to create graphics and develops learner's understanding of instructions in sequences.
